If you are experiencing interference on your licensed radiocommunications equipment you can complain to the Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago.

HOW TO COMPLAIN TO THE AUTHORITY.....TWO STEP COMPLAINT PROCESS

Step 1

Obtain the Authority's Interference Complaint Form from:
